Get ready, gardeners, for Woodland Park Zoo's first Zoo Doo sale of the year: Saturday and Sunday, March 18 and 19. Upcoming sales will be held in April, May, June and July and will be announced.

The nutrient-filled Zoo Doo is a great way to garden clean and healthy for the benefit of pollinators and other local wildlife and is a sustainable green choice. The compost is so extraordinary that the zoo's horticulture experts also use it throughout the zoo in its award-winning animal habitats and other landscaped areas.

Zoo Doo is composed of species feces pooped by a variety of the zoo's nonprimate herbivores including tapirs, pudus, mountain goats, rhinos, hippos, giraffes, zebras and more. The sweet, aromatic Zoo Doo is perfect for growing veggies and annuals.

Woodland Park Zoo has been turning out Zoo Doo for nearly 40 years. Thanks to the generosity and support from the Sunderland Foundation, a revolutionary makeover was done in 2019 to the Zoo Doo compost system. Support from Microsoft has also contributed to system improvements. The modifications now make it possible for Dr. Doo, aka the Princess of Poo, the GM of BM, or the Captain of Caca, to produce more of the compost year round.
