Enjoy spring-themed enrichment for animals, special animal keeper talks, animal training demonstrations, discovery stations and biofacts, arts and crafts, expert horticulture talks and demonstrations, a scavenger hunt, games, bouncy houses, live musical performances for kids and more! Encounter a variety of ambassador animals at the Mobile Zoo. Spring Spectacular will also open a window to the importance of native planting and the small things people can do in their own yards to protect pollinators.

Get up close and personal with goats, sheep and other domestic farm animals in the Family Farm Contact Area from 10:00–noon and 1:00–3:00.

The spring-themed treats for the animals are part of the zoo's excellent animal care program to help enrich the lives of the zoo's animals. **COST:** Spring Spectacular is free with zoo admission or membership. Zoo admission: Adult (13-64) \$29.00; Senior (65+) \$27.00; Child (3-12) \$18.00; Toddler (0-2) Free.

Discount for people with disabilities: \$2 off regular admission; 1:1 aides are complimentary. Active, retired, reserve, and veteran U.S. military and their families receive an admission discount of \$3 off zoo admission for themselves and up to six (6) family members. Zoo members receive unlimited zoo admission year round.
