Tickets go on sale Aug. 18 for Woodland Park Zoo's 10th annual Brew at the Zoo

WHAT: Cheers to conservation! Woodland Park Zoo will be holding its 10th annual **Brew at the Zoo presented by Alaska Airlines**. Tickets go on sale Friday, August 18.

Come on over for an evening of delicious beer tasting! For this outdoor event, sample different imports, domestics, microbrews and ciders coming from 50 different local breweries. And the best part? All ticket sales go toward the care of all the zoo's animals, as well as different wildlife conservation projects in the Pacific Northwest and around the world!

Brew at the Zoo typically sells out well in advance of the event, so buy your tickets early online at www.zoo.org/brew! General admission tickets include seven tastings (with more available for purchase at the zoo), ambassador animal encounters and access to some award-winning exhibits at the zoo. Premium tickets include all those things *plus* a commemorative tasting glass, an exclusive ambassador animal experience, early entry to the event at 5:00 p.m. and five additional tasting tickets.

Brew at the Zoo is for adults 21 and over only; valid ID is required for entry, no exceptions.
