# Woodland Park Zoo Hosts Hiring Fair on March 19 for Seasonal Temporary Employees



Woodland Park Zoo is hosting a hiring fair for current and upcoming job openings. Prospective candidates can meet with hiring managers to learn more about opportunities, participate in group or individual interviews or schedule a future interview date. Daytime, weekend and evening shifts will be available (see sample jobs below)! All applicants will be required to submit an application online via zoo.org/jobs prior to a job offer. This event is meant for candidates ages 18 and older.

WHEN:

Tuesday, March 19, 2024 3:30-5:30 p.m.

WHERE:

Woodland Park Zoo's Center for Wildlife Conservation Boardroom. Prospective candidates can enter for free through the CWC entrance (5500 Phinney Ave N, Seattle, WA, 98103), which is closest to the main West Entrance. They will then be directed to the CWC Boardroom for the event.

## What to bring:

This is a zoo event, so no business attire needed. Wear clothing that makes you feel confident!

### **Departments and Temporary Roles Hiring for the Season:**

Camp Supervisor (Learning & Innovation team): \$25 per hour This position supervises, coaches, and supports a team of Camp Instructors who present programs, experiences, and activities for the zoo's camp programs for youth. This is a seasonal position starting from late May 2024 to September 06, 2024.

# Camp Inclusion Specialist (Learning & Innovation team): \$23 per hour

This position plays an important role in the facilitation and leadership of Woodland Park Zoo's summer camp, ensuring inclusion of all individuals that participate in camp programs. With the Manager, the Camp Inclusion Specialist will help train and support Camp Instructors on inclusion practices and resources and modify existing camp programs to ensure quality participation by all. This position works with campers ages 5-13. This is a seasonal position from June 03, 2024, to September 06, 2024.

Camp Coordinator (Learning & Innovation team): \$23 per hour

This position is responsible for coordinating daily camp operations and logistics and improving customer experience. This position requires interaction with the public and employees throughout various stages of the program. Work entails various program support activities, including preparing program marketing and education materials, monitoring participation, maintaining records, preparing reports, and assisting with program operations and special events. There are two coordinator assignments, scheduling and extended care. This is a seasonal position lasting from June 03, 2024, to September 06, 2024.

Camp Instructor (Learning & Innovation team): \$20 per hour This position is responsible for the presentation of programs, experiences and activities for the zoo's camp programs for youth. This is a seasonal position from June 14, 2024, to August 30, 2024.

Animal Management: Exhibit Attendants: \$20 per hour

This position is responsible for the presentation of programs, experiences, and activities for families and guests visiting the zoo.

#### Horticulture: Assistant Gardeners: \$25.11 per hour

This role assists in the propagating, planting, cultivating, watering, and fertilizing of flowers, plants, shrubs, trees and other plant materials. This role also prepares, plants and maintains assigned areas.

Grounds: Laborer (Grounds and Events): \$27.18 per hour
This role performs routine janitorial and custodial work in assigned
areas as well as routine manual work in a variety of indoor and
outdoor spaces related to event set-up and break-down.

Admissions: Ticketing and Membership Associate: \$20 per hour This position welcomes guests through the zoo's entry gates and operates the carousel.

Full Time positions: People & Culture (HR) will have a table to discuss any open regular positions that are available as of March 19.
