WHAT: Celebrate all things spring on Saturday, April 13 at Woodland Park Zoo's Spring Spectacular! COST: Spring Spectacular is free with zoo admission or membership. Admission prices vary daily based on anticipated demand. Visit tickets.zoo.org for current prices; tickets purchased four or more days in advance receive a 10% discount. Toddlers 0-2 are free and seniors receive a discount. Zoo members receive unlimited zoo admission year-round.

Discount for people with disabilities: \$2 off regular admission; 1:1 aides are complimentary. Active, retired, reserve, and veteran U.S. military and their families: \$3 off zoo admission for themselves and up to six (6) family members.
