



Color your picture any way you choose, then cut it out on the dotted lines and try your luck at putting the puzzle back together! Can you do it?






### CURIOUS KEAS




### COLORING ZINE FOLDING GUIDE

Fold paper in half.


Note: Text should be on the outside.




Fold paper in half again.




Fold paper in half again, then open paper back to the first fold.




Cut along the center fold to the intersection of the fold lines, creating a slit in the paper.



Open the paper flat.




Fold vertically and rotate.

Find the beginning and end pages and fold together.







#### FOREST CHARADES

#### **HOW TO PLAY:**


Gather everyone in one room. Each player needs to choose one forest-dwelling species to represent (orangutan, owl, red panda, tiger, tree kangaroo, bear, kea, snake—you decide!—but don't reveal your species yet).

The oldest player goes first. They read (or say) one prompt below, then all the other players have to follow. Play until all the players have had a turn and everyone has guessed each other's species correctly. (Act out each prompt, make noises and get wild!)




# TOCO TOUCAN COLOR BY NUMBERS




