We can all do our part to make sure our palm oil is sustainable and deforestation-free to protect wildlife. We dare you to take the Sweet Treat Challenge!



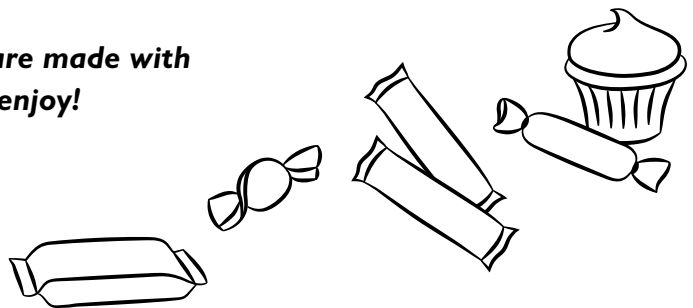

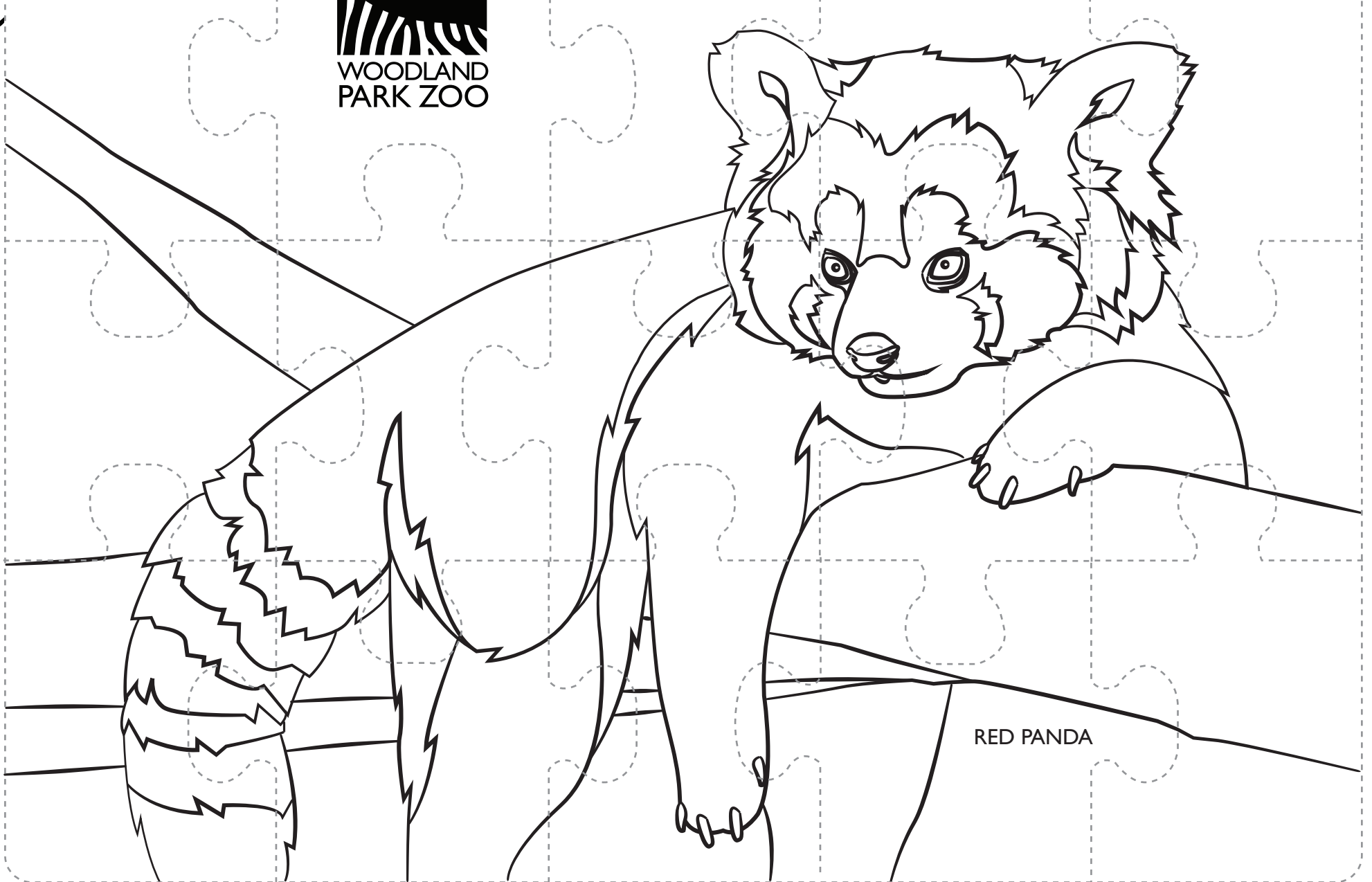

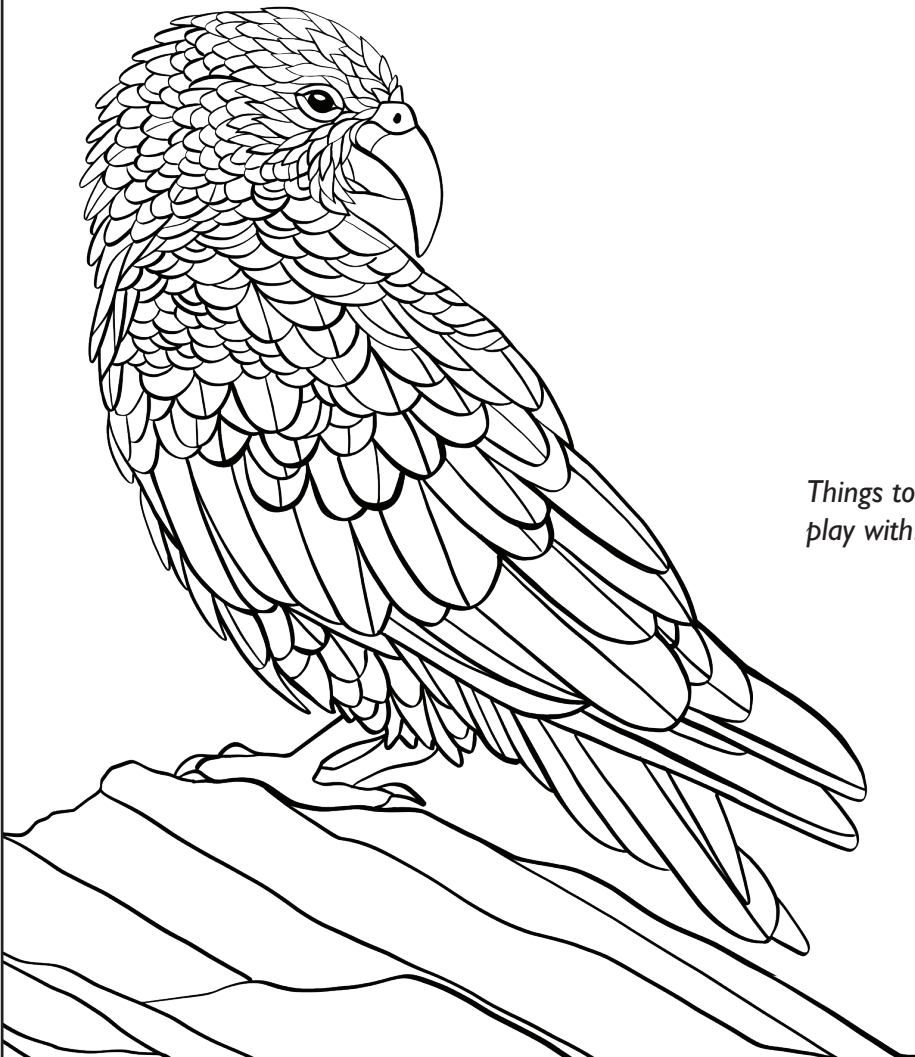
# DESIGN A FOREST HOME FOR CURIOUS KEAS

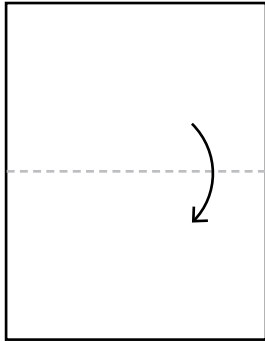

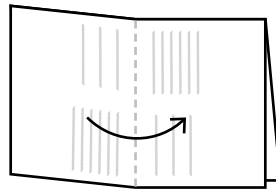

Use these folding instructions for the coloring zine on the following page.

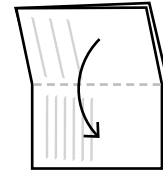


Fold paper in half.

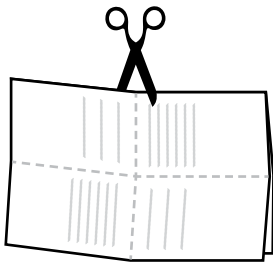
*Note: Text should be on the outside.*



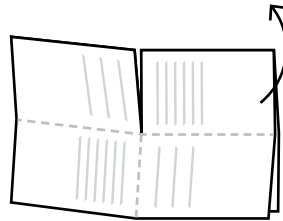
Fold paper in half again.



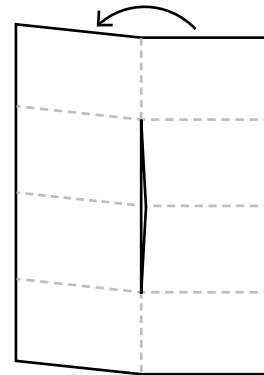
Fold paper in half again, then open paper back to the first fold.



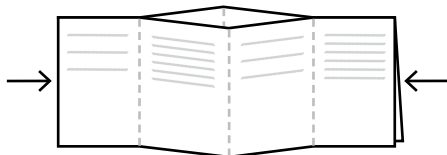
Cut along the center fold to the intersection of the fold lines, creating a slit in the paper.



Open the paper flat.

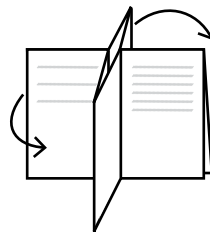


Fold vertically and rotate.



Push the two ends toward each other.

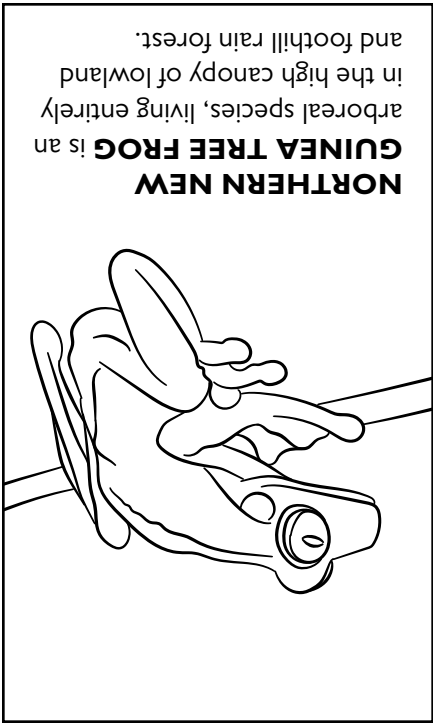

**NORTHERN NEW GUINEA TREE FROG** is an arboreal species, living entirely in the high canopy of lowland and foothill rain forest.



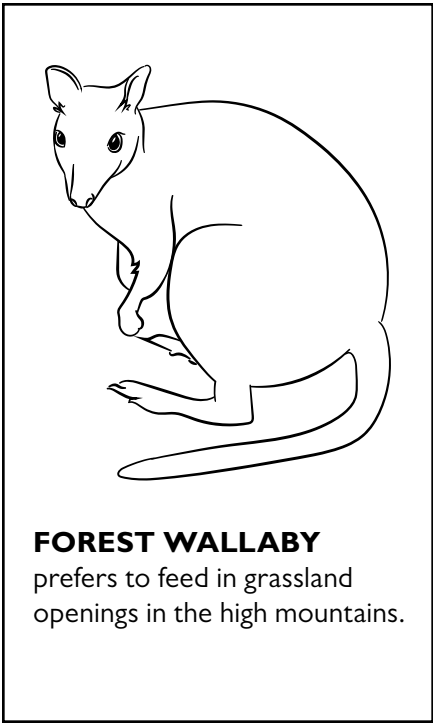
**TUBE-NOSED FRUIT BATS** roost in living foliage and are found primarily in wet tropical lowlands, as well as in mid-elevation montane forests.



**BLUE EMPEROR BUTTERFLIES** can be spotted in the gardens and villages of PNG, where the Tree Kangaroo Conservation Program is based.



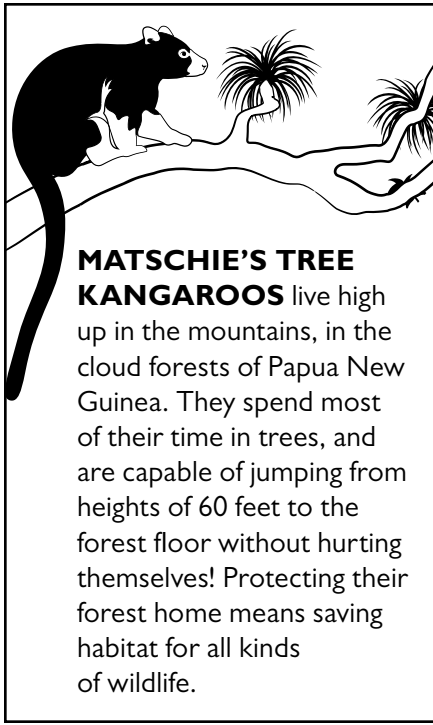
**LONG-BEAKED ECHIDNA** uses its unique beak to search for earthworms and other invertebrates in the soil.



**FOREST WALLABY** prefers to feed in grassland openings in the high mountains.



**NEW GUINEA HARPY-EAGLE** hunts large mammals including tree kangaroos, wallabies and possums!



**MATSCHIE'S TREE KANGAROOS** live high up in the mountains, in the cloud forests of Papua New Guinea. They spend most of their time in trees, and are capable of jumping from heights of 60 feet to the forest floor without hurting themselves! Protecting their forest home means saving habitat for all kinds of wildlife.

# LET'S PLAY FOREST CHARADES

Red pandas, tree kangaroos and keas all have one thing in common—they are true tree lovers! These species, and so many more, rely on healthy forests to thrive.

## HOW TO PLAY:

Gather everyone in one room. Each player needs to choose one forest-dwelling species to represent (orangutan, owl, red panda, tiger, tree kangaroo, bear, kea, snake—you decide!)—but don't reveal your species yet).

The oldest player goes first. They read (or say) one prompt below, then all the other players have to follow. Play until all the players have had a turn and everyone has guessed each other's species correctly. (Act out each prompt, make noises and get wild!)

*My home is in the trees, I need the forest to SLEEP like this \_\_\_\_\_.*

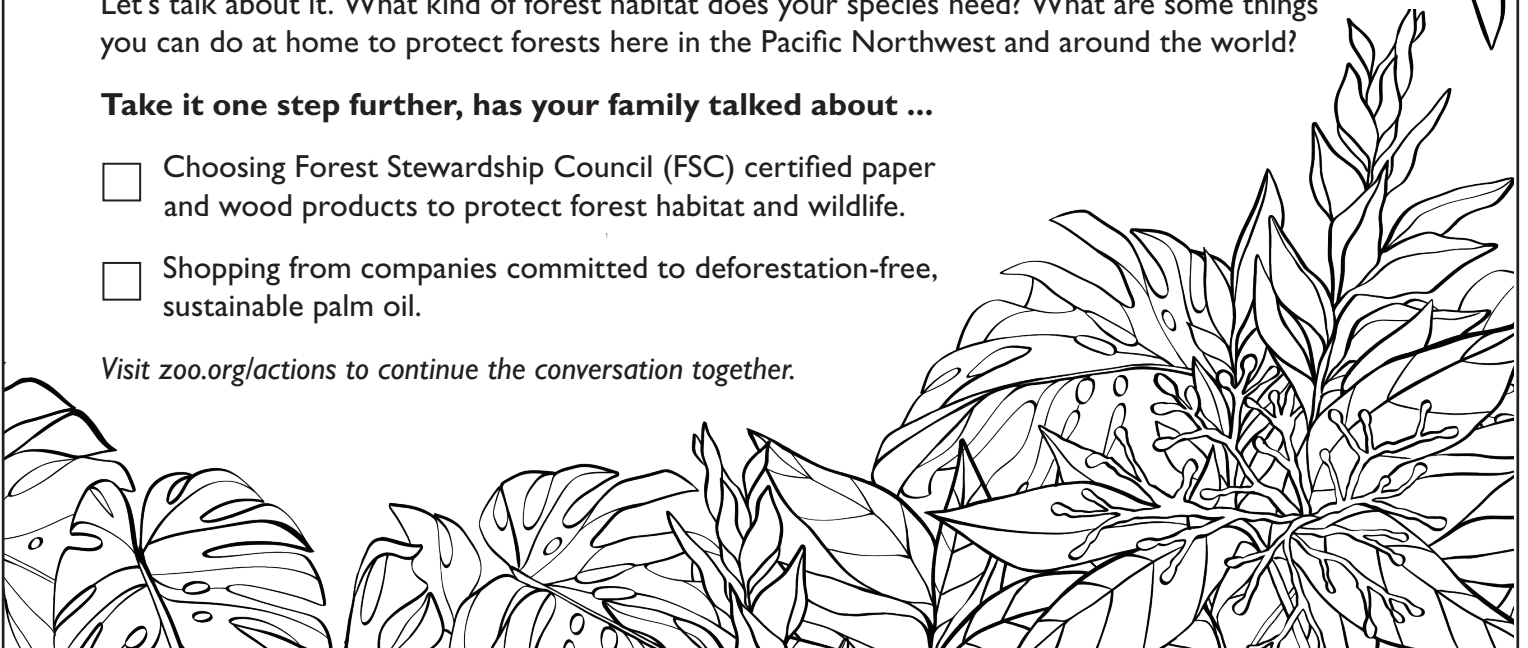
