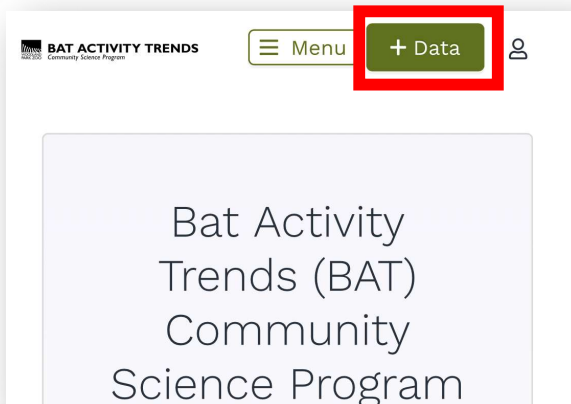

ADD DATA TO FIELDSCOPE

1. Log into your FieldScope account:
<https://bat.fieldscope.org/>



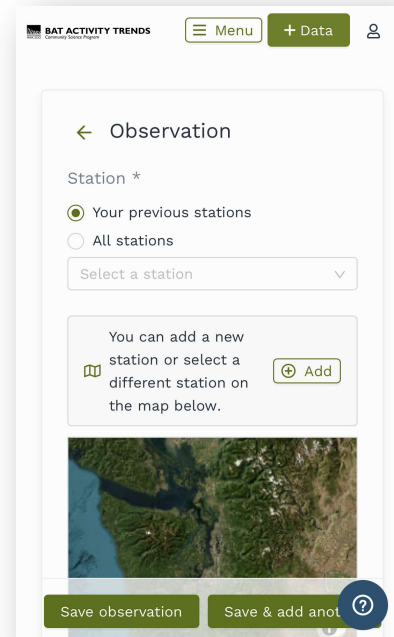
Once logged in, select the “+ Data” button in the top right corner:



2. The first thing to enter is you Station location. If you entered data at a station before, select the “Your previous stations” option and choose your station from the drop down menu.

If the station is new for you, it’s possible someone else has surveyed there previously. Highlight the “All stations” option and search for your station in the drop down menu.

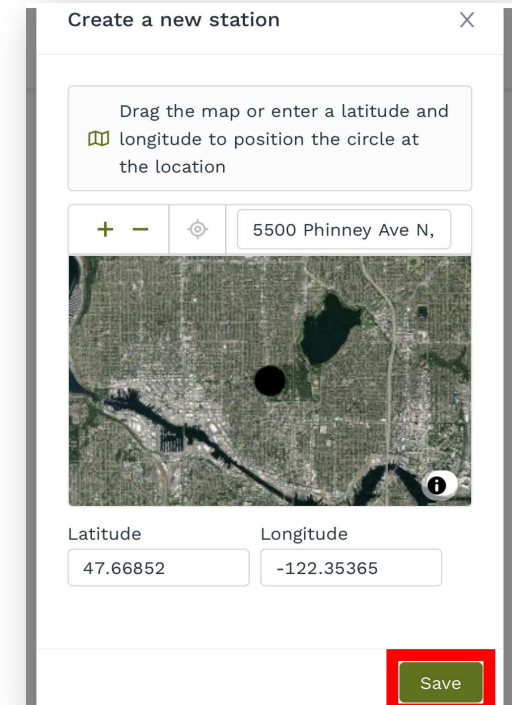
If this is a completely new station, click the “+ Add” button above the map.



3. To add a new station, either type your address in the “Location Search” box or enter a latitude and longitude. The dot will move to that location to mark your station.

Click “Save.”

Note: To move down to the next section of the form, move your cursor over and click into the "Station Name" box below the map rather than scrolling down as this can sometimes move your station on the map!





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4. Next enter a station name formatted as “Neighborhood/Station Name.”

(Ex: Phinney Ridge/Woodland Park Zoo)

Remember:

- For private residences, use an intersection for the “Station Name.”
Ex: Fremont/N. 36th St & Troll Ave. N
- For parks and other public sites, use the park or site’s name for the “Station Name.” If it’s a large site, you can include a more specific location in the Station Name along with the site name.
Ex: Broadview/Carkeek Beach Parking
- If you are doing a walking survey, your site name will be your start and end point.

Enter the station’s City and Zip code then click “Create” in the bottom left.
